

ACCREDITATION SCHEDULE OF FEES

ANZPAC charges education providers to assess programs of study for accreditation. Fees vary depending on the type of accreditation required and are charged for each program of study offered by an education provider. Full ANZPAC accreditation is generally granted for five years. Fees are reviewed on a regular basis and may change from time to time.

1. Accreditation Fee – Initial and Subsequent Accreditation of Programs

Education providers will be invoiced on acceptance of the Self Evaluation Report (SER). Fees are effective for SERs received on or after 1 January 2015.

These fees include the costs for one site visit by ANZPAC's assessment team. An additional \$5,000 + GST will be charged for each additional visit.

Different fees may apply if an education provider submits an incomplete SER or if the SER requires substantial additional information to enable a site visit to proceed.

New program of study \$30,000.00 AUD + GST Existing program of study \$30,000.00 AUD + GST

2. Major Change to an Accredited Program of Study *

Programs requiring 1 site visit \$10,000.00 AUD + GST

Programs requiring > 1 site visit \$5,000 AUD + GST per extra site visit

3. Follow Up of Conditions of an Accredited Program of Study

Programs requiring 1 site visit \$10,000.00 AUD + GST

Programs requiring > 1 site visit \$5,000 AUD + GST per extra site visit

4. Assessment of Web Based Case Studies

\$2,500.00 AUD + GST

5. Appeals

Cost recovery plus 20% administration fee

* Major change is defined in the ANZPAC Accreditation Procedures for Podiatry Programs for Australia and New Zealand as "substantive matters that will affect the policy or practices of an education provider and that could impact upon the delivery of a program of study, including modification, alteration, addition, amendment, substitution or deletion of any aspect of the program or education provider, that causes the changes to the substance, structure, form, delivery or outcomes of the program such that students are completing a program of study that is different to the program that was accredited."
